The payment schedule is as follows:

Payment	Amount	Date Due
Deposit	\$100	October 14
Payment 2	\$300	December 2
Payment 3	\$300	February 10
Payment 4	\$400*	April 14

*Payment 4 is an estimate but will be within \$100. We will not know the total until we officially purchase all of the tickets for all of our outings. This information will be made known to you as soon as the trip is secured.

At this time, we will begin accepting deposits for \$100 per traveler. This is a nonrefundable deposit and must be accompanied by the Trip Commitment Contract. All spots will be reserved in a first come, first served fashion and must be paid in full with contract in order to be considered.

We will continue to accept deposits from tonight until the trip is full. There are only 50 total spots so please get your deposit in as soon as possible. We will also allow parents/family members to go on the trip. If you or your family member would like to attend, please let Ms. Bowen know ASAP to be added to a list.
